Resin Bonded and Resin Bound Aggregate surfacing

A **Resin Bound Aggregate** system fully meets SuDS requirements, and is a decorative, functional seamless surface designed to reduce the potential of flooding on urban developments.

The open matrix of the Resin Bound System will allow water to drain through to the base, and reduce water ponding, in turn this action will naturally feed any surrounding planted areas and trees.

A **Resin Bonded Aggregate** system is used to create a decorative finish with the look of a natural aggregate surface without loose gravel, providing non-slip, durable, hardwearing and low maintenance surface.

The typical areas of use for **Resin Bonded**, and **Resin Bound**

systems are driveways, ramps, paths, large landscaping areas, balconies, roof gardens, roads, patios, podium decks, car parks and general public areas, to create an aesthetically pleasing appearance which is achieved by using a range of different colours and aggregate sizes.

The **Resin Bonded**, and **Resin Bound** systems can also incorporate a waterproof membrane for use in suspended structures such as balconies and podium decks, and also **Resin Bound Tree Pit System** which is also decorative, but designed to be highly porous, allowing the tree to feed, and help to reduce the build up of litter and mess.
